

Information on Testing for COVID19



The Vermont Department of Health is coordinating the testing for COVID19.

NVRH is offering “drive through” testing outside the Parking Lot E near the Emergency Room.

Enter through the Emergency Department entrance and drive down and around to the lower parking lot (Lot E).

- An appointment is required. Your health care provider will arrange for testing by calling the NVRH outpatient testing site and **making an appointment for you.**
- If you do not have a primary health care provider call NVRH at 748-8141 and ask for the “on-call primary care provider”.
- Testing is available for:
 - A person who has COVID19 symptoms (fever and cough)
 - Anyone traveling to, or returning to, Vermont who wishes to reduce their quarantine time.
 - A person preparing for elective surgery.
- When you arrive at the Tent Testing site at the time of your appointment
 - **Stay in your vehicle**
 - **If no one comes out to your vehicle**
 - **Call the NVRH screening site at (802)745-6441**
- A nurse will swab you in the nose
- You will be given a mask and written instructions
- Go home and stay home to reduce the risk of infection to others
- Results from the Vermont Department of Health will be available in 24-72 hours. Your healthcare provider will let you know the results and give you more information about your care
