In an attempt to facilitate prompt entry into the NVRH system the following documentation is **required** for students prior to anticipated start date. If the documentation is not provided in a timely manner it may delay the anticipated start date.

1. Proof of immunizations:

- Either medical documentation of 2 doses of **Measles, Mumps, Rubella** (MMR) vaccine OR positive titer (lab work) indicating immunity. This would need to be current-- less than 1 year from the anticipated start date OR medical records confirming a past diagnosis of measles, mumps and rubella.
- Either medical documentation of 2 doses of **Varicella** (Chicken pox) vaccine OR positive titer, indicating immunity---done less than 1 year from anticipated start date OR medical records confirming past diagnosis of varicella. In the absence of varicella immunity if age is > 50, vaccination proof of Zoster/Shingles replaces Varicella.
- Results of **Tuberculosis** (TB) testing either by Purified Protein Derivative (PPD) OR Quanteferon test performed less than 1 year from start of rotation.
- Medical documentation of Flu Vaccine administration for current Flu season.
- Tetanus/Diphtheria /Pertussis (TDaP) done within the past 10 years and Hepatitis B titer done less than 1 year from start date are both recommended (not required)
- Documentation of vaccination for COVID-19

2. Return Completed OSHA Respirator Clearance Questionnaire.

3. COVID-19 testing by PCR method must be done 3-5 days prior to the start of rotation. Copy of test result required.

Eligibility for a student rotation or internship:

Any student who needs to have clinical or non-clinical hospital based hours to meet requirements for a course or degree to work in a healthcare related field.
