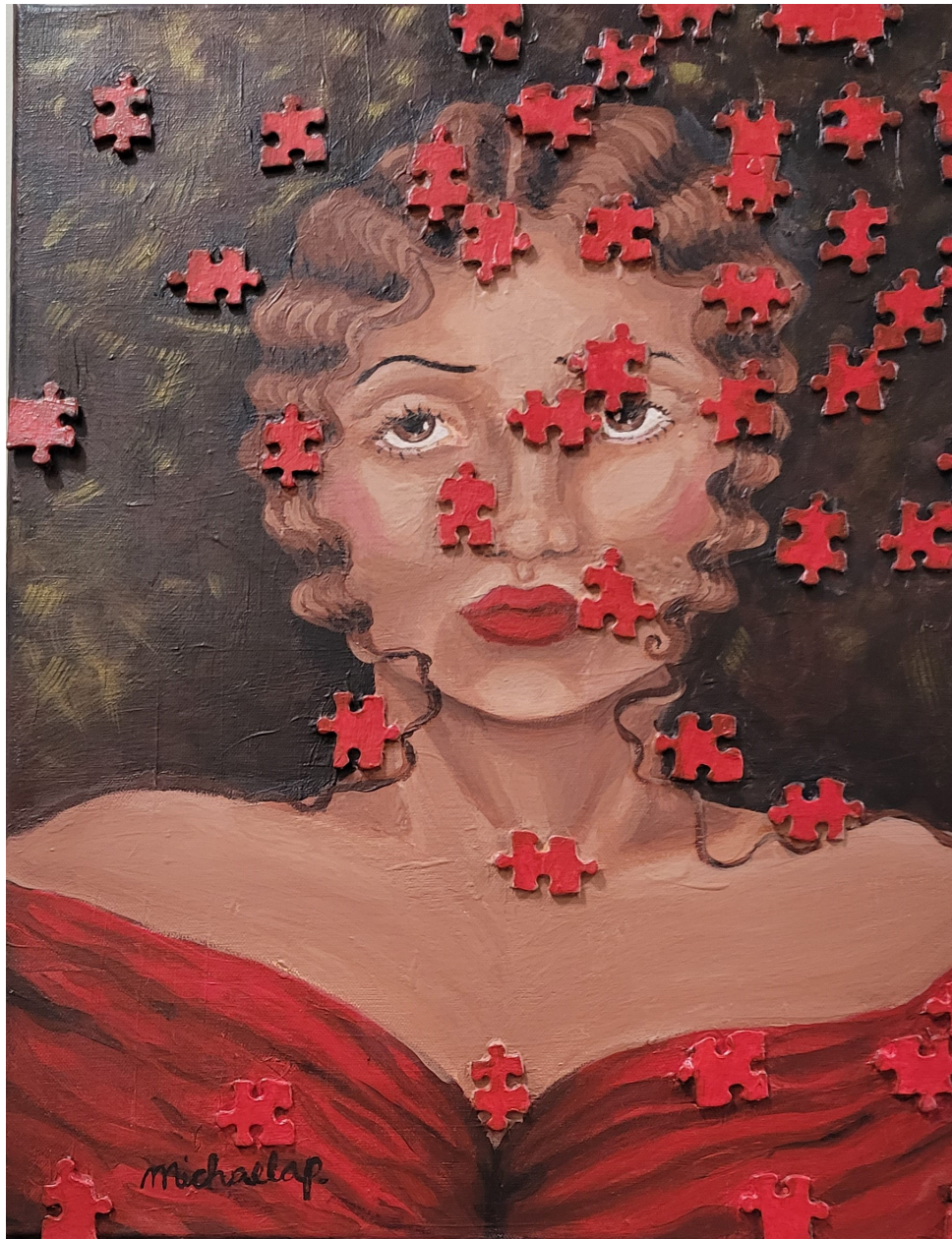


The Charles M. & Hanna H. Gray Gallery
