Kate Arslambakova is an artist, working primarily with oils, acrylic, collage on paper and mixed media. Kate has been painting since early childhood and received her BFA in painting and MA in Arts Administration from Florida State University. Arslambakova is currently enrolled in the Master of Fine Arts program at the Vermont State University, Johnson. Since 2008, Arslambakova has participated in numerous group exhibitions, including solo exhibitions at Renditions: An Art Space (2011), Studio Place Arts (2023), Kellogg-Hubbard Library (2024). Her works can be seen in venues throughout Vermont. She currently curates the CVMC Art Gallery at the Central Vermont Medical Center.

Kate Arslambakova Artists Statement

Since a young age, I have been fascinated by the world inside us, how these complex systems develop and work together to help us function. While working in a lab after undergrad, I delved into the microscopic world which explicitly impacted the direction my art practice would take. In my current work, I attempt to dissect, reconstruct, and connect the structures of the body with the outside world. Through the visual play of colors, textures and shapes in each painting, I aim to arouse curiosity of the viewer and lure them in for a closer look, in hopes to elicit a dialogue about their relationship with their own anatomy.
